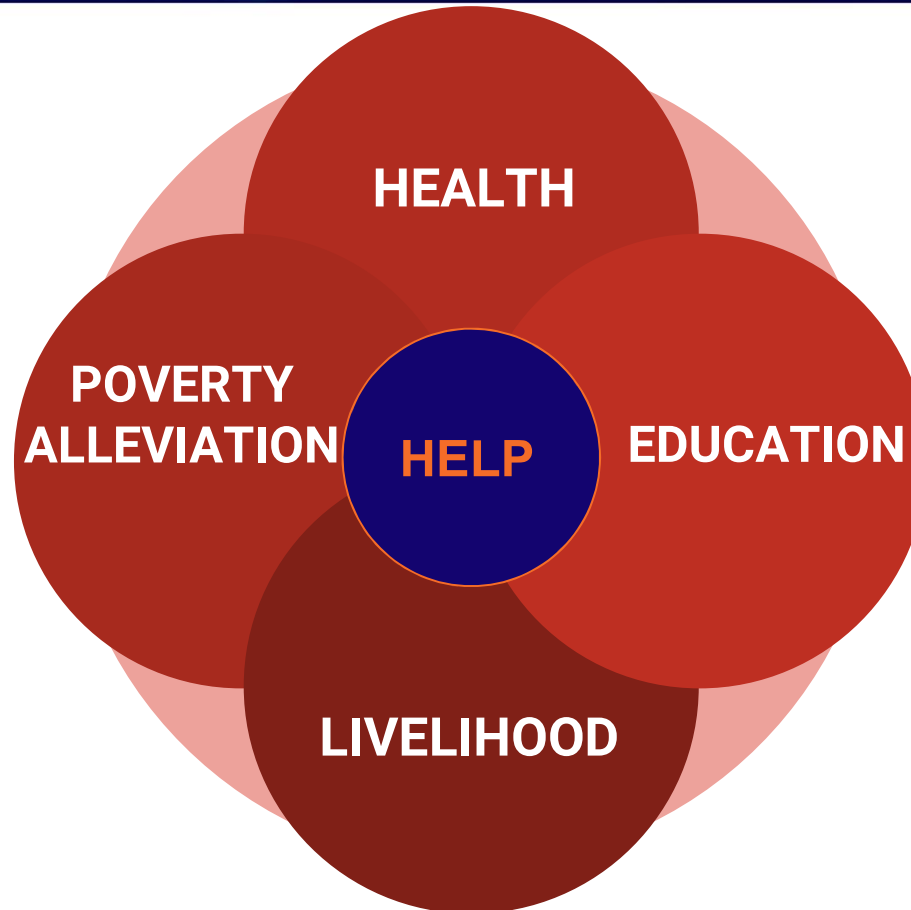

Health Emergency Services - Govt. Hospital



IIFL Foundation developed 'Emergency Services' at Maharana Bhupal Government Hospital, Udaipur (Rajasthan) - **3 Operation Theatres, 6-Bed Intensive Care (ICU),** Outpatient Department (OPD), Cabins for Resident doctors and waiting area for family members of the patients.

The work was completed along with installation of Medical Equipment *viz.* Anesthesia workstations (Imported from Germany), OT Table Hydraulic, ICU Beds, Multipara patient monitors, OT Dome Lights and medical gas pipeline system.

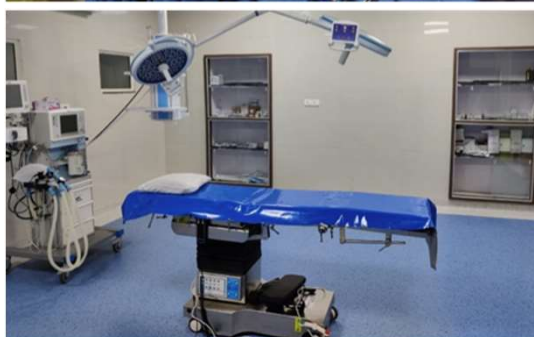

Education Sakhiyon ki Baadi

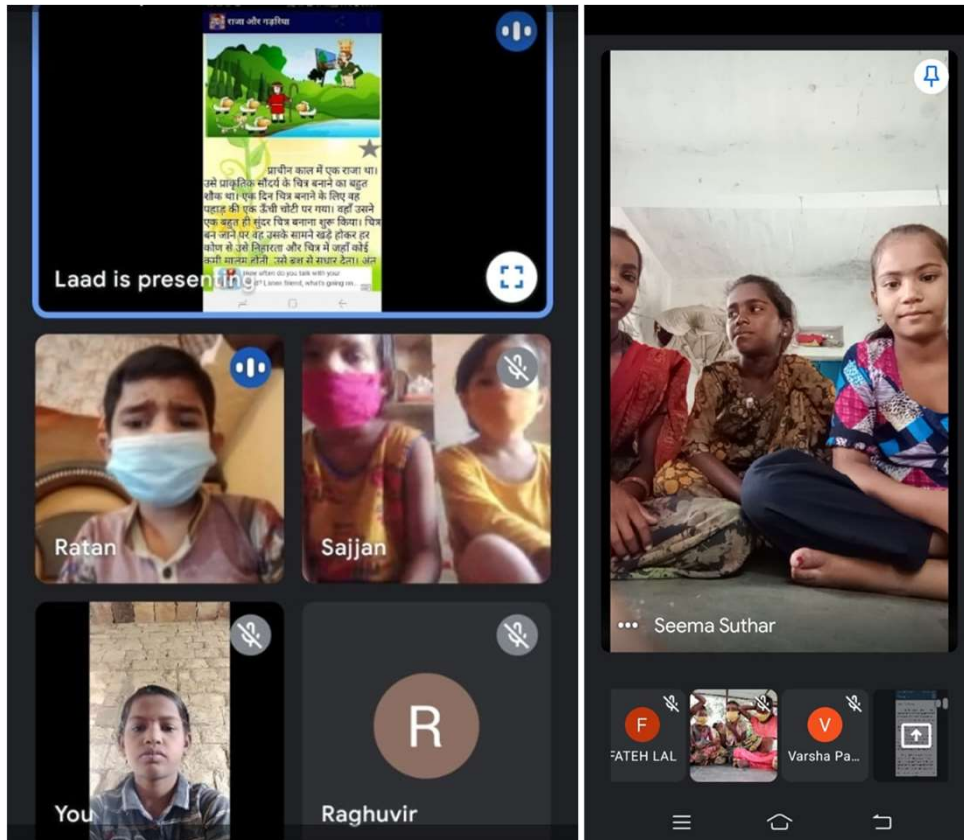


IIFL Foundation has committed to eradicate female illiteracy from Rajasthan with our **Sakhiyon ki Baadi** program - a community based learning center delivering **Foundational Literacy & Numeracy (FLN) Skills**

Each Sakhiyon Ki Baadi operates for **4 hours a day** and **6 six days of a week**. Learning at Sakhiyon Ki Baadi happens through **interactive sessions** by adopting **play- way method, music, drama and exposure to the field**.

The initiative covertly contributes to conservation of Indigenous languages, provides **employment to females from Scheduled tribe communities** and promotes skill building among the marginalized communities.

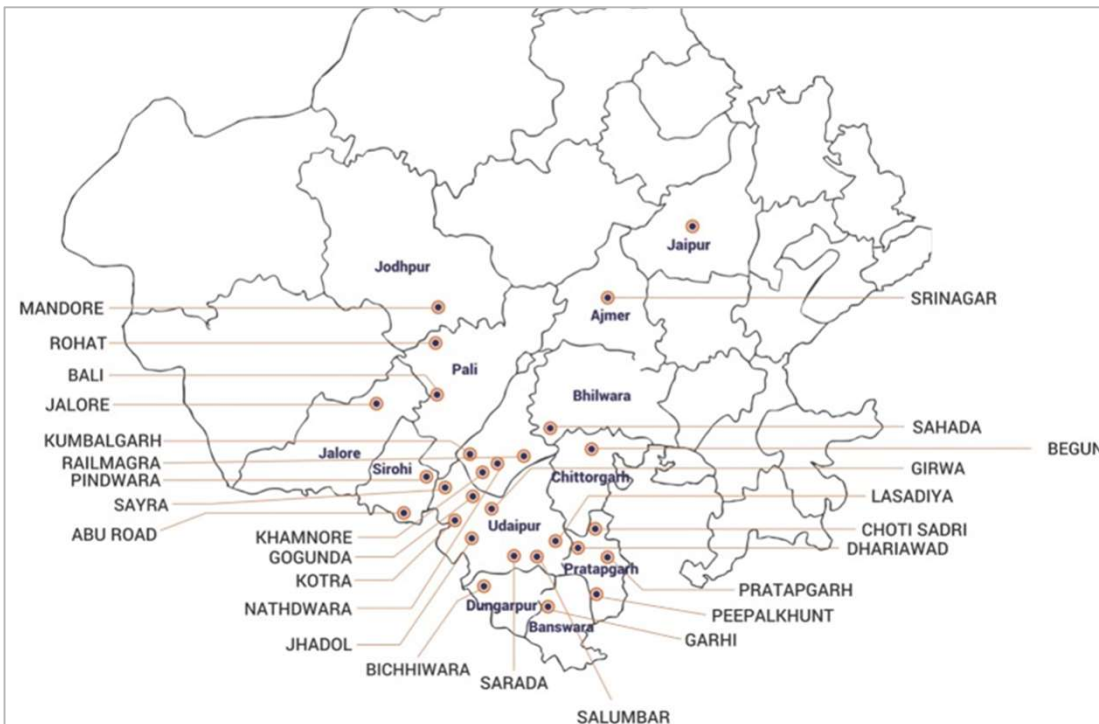

Education Chauras



Chauras is a learning centre cum crèche for children of labourers (migrant) working at construction sites, brick kiln and Mineral grinding unit.

The centre from 9:00 am to 5:30 pm through the weekdays and provides Education (Foundational literacy) & Nutritional meals to the children, in the age group that spans from 3 months to 14 years of age.

We currently conduct **10 learning-cum-crèche facilities 3 different states**. The sites are carefully selected keeping in mind the scope for long term intervention, following a holistic approach (nutrition, health, learning, and community strengthening, in a caring and protecting environment).

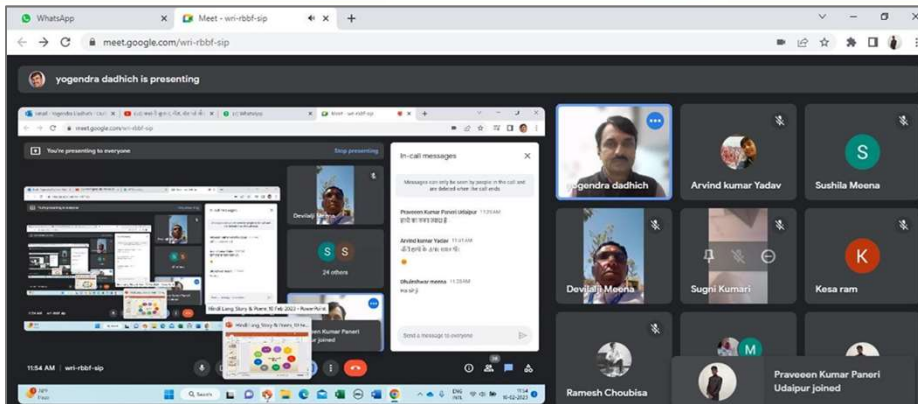

Education Niti Aayog & Smart Shaala, Rajasthan



IIFL Foundation has started training teachers from **government schools** positively impacting education of students in **five aspirational districts** of Rajasthan - **Dholpur, Baran, Karauli, Jaisalmer** and **Sirohi**. The project will also provide learning kits, smart education apps and residential training facilities.



IIFL Foundation, has implemented the biggest **TV based learning programme** (Smart Shaala) along with dissemination of the **Math Kits** in three districts of Rajasthan - **Bikaner, Jaipur** and **Jodhpur**.

This project shall help to **reduce the dropping out of students from Govt. Schools**, especially among girls.

Education Niti Aayog, Uttar Pradesh



IIFL Foundation is supporting Sampark Foundation, to carry out the educational programme as implemented at Rajasthan, further in **two aspirational districts** of Uttar Pradesh: **Sonbhadra** and **Chitrakoot**.

The team is working with the SCERT, District Education Departments, and Block Education Departments for the execution.

The initiative is seeing positive support from the government officials at all levels in Uttar Pradesh and has raised the interest levels of DM (District Magistrate) and CDO (Chief Development Officer), who are looking ahead to raise the literacy level in the respective blocks.

Through this initiative, IIFL Foundation will have an **impact** on lives of nearly **2.72 lac students** and **5,582 teachers**

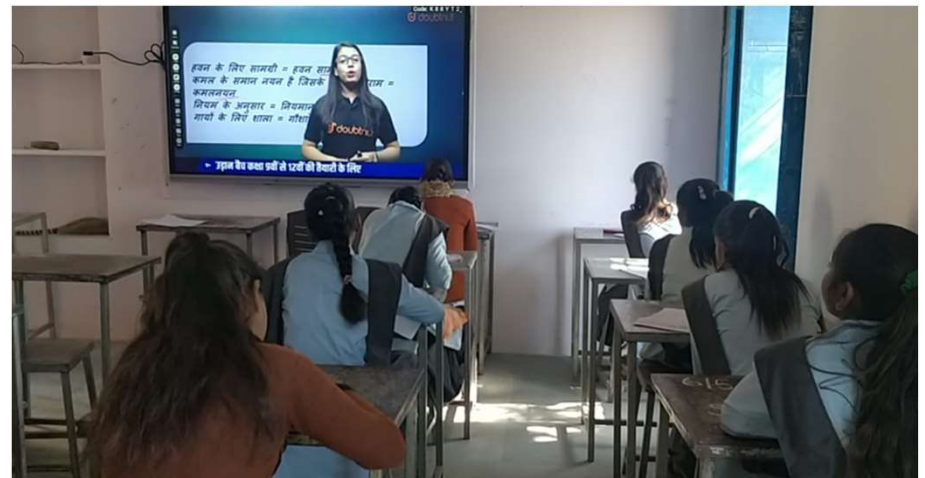

A Project for improving learning and mental well being outcomes for young children in **Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan.**, through use of **community radio**

The overall objective of the Project is to launch '**Choti-Badi Baatein**' to address the loss of mental wellbeing and key foundational learning abilities for young children in skill building of caregivers.

The Project is being delivered through an inclusive curriculum through Community Radio ('CR') stations and through interactions with children and parents/caregivers in communities in Jhunjhunu district in the state of Rajasthan.

Each week one fresh episode of 15 minutes is aired followed by three repeats in the same week.

Approx **2.5 lakh** population through radio broadcast
Approx **1000 children** and **1000 caregivers** directly in community

Project duration is of **1 year**.

Education & Shelter Home for underprivileged



We've been supporting education of the children from the **Financially weaker section** of the community residing at Janupada Vaibhav Nagar locality (slum settlement) located at Kandivali (E), Mumbai.

The school was on verge of closing down during 2018, facing scarcity of funds and since then IIFL Foundation has helped them sustain the operations. **Children are offered education without charging any fee**

Shelter Home

IIFL Foundation supports education & overall development of children at a Shelter Home in Mumbai. The facility nurtures children from marginalised section of the society that struggles to have access to basic necessities for survival.

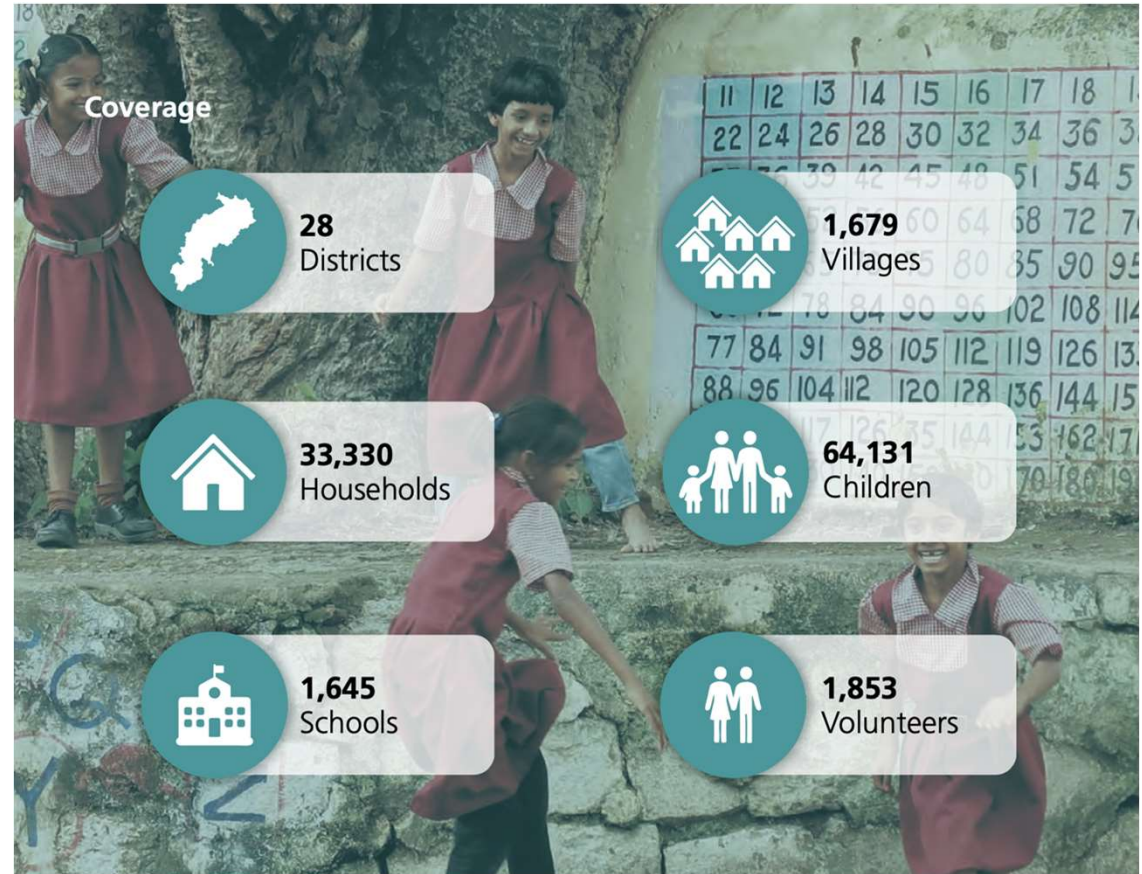


Education ASER Testing - Chhattisgarh

IIFL Foundation launched Rajasthan's first agriculture drone. The custom made Drone is built exclusively for Research in advancement of agriculture. The drone is donated to Maharana Pratap University of Agriculture & Technology (MPUAT), Udaipur, Rajasthan.



The custom made drone is designed and built by **blueINFINITY Innovation Labs**, Mumbai., who previously also built a Drone for Covid-19 vaccine delivery via drone in Maharashtra, having a capacity to fly in a radius of 25 kms.

The project aims to empower **180 young women** and men in Kupwara to bring holistic professional development enabling them to embark on a Retail Associate career path thereby contributing to the economic & social development of Kashmir and the country.

We reached out to Retailers Association's Skill Council of India (RASCI), Skill India, and Government of India to align the curriculum with Retail Sales Associate trade guidelines.

The program is regularly monitored by the India Army officers. Town Commander **Col Navalgatti** and **Captain Aditya Pandey** closely monitor the Retail center.

Livestock Development Programme



Under Livestock Development Programme, through Artificial Insemination project, IIFL Foundation has supported farmers from low income groups to venture and progress in the vertical of Dairy production. This Livestock Development project is operational in 2 states across India – Rajasthan & Karnataka, with a total of 5 centres.

This initiative provides services / inputs at the doorstep of the cattle owners to encourage and maintain livestock rearing as a secondary source of income, promote production of dairy services.

Sewing Machines



With a view to promote skilled training to women so they can generate Livelihood, IIFL Foundation has donated **101 Sewing Machines** to women at rural villages in **Chittorgarh district** of **Rajasthan**.

Chartered Financial Expert (CFX) is a **short-term professional certification** targeted at preparing candidates for a **successful career in Banking, Financial Services and Insurance Industry**.

Its a comprehensive certification course giving a **360-degree view of BFSI sector** – Savings, Protection, Investment and Lending. Offers placement assistance **with BFSI corporates**.

This certification is supported by leading industry educational institutions like **National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM), L.N.Welingkar Institute of Management Development and Research (WeSchool)** and **Centre for Investment Education & Learning (CIEL)**

200 women candidates were trained during FY 22-23.

Candidates are selected as on basis of their performance on following parameters:

1. Score in 12th Std.
2. Family Income (Lower Income Groups)
3. Personal Interview

From the selected candidates **79% of individuals have a score of 70% and above** in their 12th grade, 98% are pursuing their Bachelors degree (Third Year) and 62% have an **annual family income less than Rs. 3 lakh**

एमपीयूएटी के अडिशनल ऑफ टेक्नोलॉजी एंड इंजीनियरिंग (सीटीआई) के इंस्ट्रक्शनल फार्म में एग्रीकल्चर ड्रोन लॉन्च हुआ। किसानों को फलाने यह ड्रोन फलाने साढ़े तीन मिनट में एक एकड़ यानी करीब साढ़े दो बीघे फसल पर कीड़े मारने और खरपतवार कटौती का कैमिकल छिड़केंगे। यही काम किसान मैनुअली या स्टे फॉलन से 3-30 घंटे से भी ज्यादा समय करते हैं। ऑटोपिलॉटिंग टैक्निक (एआई) से इस ड्रोन को इस तरह प्रोग्राम किया गया है कि जहां से उड़ेंगे, वहां क्षेत्रों को कवर कर देकर खाली होने पर वहीं लौट आया। एग्रीकल्चर ड्रोन का दायरा है कि यह खेत के कृषि संयंत्रों में अपनी तरह का पहला तकनीकी नवाचार है। स्मार्ट विलेज संयोजक डॉ. आई.जे. माधुर ने बताया कि 30 लाख रुपये लागत का यह ड्रोन मुंबई के आईआईएफएल फाउंडेशन ने रिचार्ज और एग्जैकशन के लिए एमपीयूएटी को दिया है। ड्रोन के लॉन्चिंग समारोह में आईआईएफएल निदेशक मधु जैन, आरएनटी मेडिकल कॉलेज के निदेशक डॉ. लखन पोसवाल, वासिल शिंदे, डॉ. मुनील जैने, डॉ. पी.के. सिंह आदि मौजूद रहे।

एमपीयूएटी की डिजिटल टेक्नोलॉजी सेल के चेयरमैन डॉ. मुनील जैने ने बताया कि 2 मीटर व्यास के इस ड्रोन का वजन 2.4 किलो है। इसमें 6 आर्म, 6 पंखे और 3 जेनलर स्पे हैं। एक बार फूल चार्ज होने पर यह 15 मिनट तक उड़ान भरता है। कैमिकल छिड़कने से पहले यह खेत की मैपिंग कर लेता है। टेकऑफ के बाद बर्डकैम हो खेतों में छिड़काव करता है। कैमिकल छान होने या बैटरी डिस्चार्ज होने पर भी यही वहीं लैंड करता है, जहां से उड़ान भरता। ड्रोन से दवा के छिड़काव से किसानों को फेफड़ी और स्तन से जुड़ी तकलीफ को आसानी भी नहीं रहेगी।
