HEALTH

Development of Emergency Services at Maharana Bhupal Government Hospital, Udaipur

Upgradation of facility by setting up Operation Theatres, Intensive Care Unit (ICU), Outpatient Department (OPD), and Cabins for Resident doctors.

Upgradation of Primary Health Centre (PHC)

Setting up an Ophthalmic surgery ward and check-up facility, Donation of an Ultrasound machine to the Maternity ward and an Ambulance at PHC Khamnore, Rajsamand.

Mission Conquer Covid

Donated 125 Oxygen Concentrators to 16 Primary Health Centres (Rural) in 5 districts of Rajasthan and distribution of 500 Covid Relief Kits to the Corona warriors.

Donation of an Ambulance

The Foundation donated an Ambulance to Mahaveer Jain Vidhyalaya Sansthan, Mavli, Udaipur to mobilise patients from rural hamlets to Government hospital.

Aarogya

Medical check-up of 35,000+ girls engaged with our 'Sakhion ki Badi' centres, across 14 districts in Rajasthan. Children identified to have any deficiency, ailments or illness were referred to the nearest health care facility.



EDUCATION

Sakhiyon ki Baadi

Flagship programme to eradicate illiteracy from Rajasthan, among girls of 4 to 14 years in age. Active across 14 districts with 35,000+ girls from marginalised & Scheduled tribe communities (Bhil, Garasiya, Meena, Kalbeliya, Rebari, Banjara, Damor)

Rathshaala

To educate children of nomadic Rebari community, a school on Camel cart that travels along with the tribe throughout the year.

Chauras

A learning centre and crèche for children of labourers (migrant) working at construction sites, brick kiln and Mineral grinding unit. Education, Nutrition and Medical check-up to for an all-round development.

Digital Shaala

50 Digital classrooms at 25 Government schools, for students in grades 6th to 10th, along with training of teachers.

English Language Lab

To develop English language skills of students in Grade 1st to 10th, through online lectures, practise sessions and assessments.

Maa Bari Centres

Upgraded 30 Maa Baadi centers, with installation of solar panels, educational AV content, improved Water & Sanitation facilities, Play-area.

Smart Shaala

Empowering 18,194 teachers from 7,415 government schools to deliver foundational literacy and numeracy (FLN) education to 5,17,000 students from 8 districts (Inc. 5 aspirational districts).

Digital Library

50 tablets (android), integrated with school curriculum donated to girl students at The Rajkumari Ratnavati Girls School. (Jaisalmer).

Science Labs and Computer Lab

Constructed at Senior Secondary Girls School, Khamnore, and Government Girls Senior Residency School, Udaipur.

Digital Tablets (Android)

Donated 200 Android Tablets at various government schools to ensure continuity in education of students post-COVID, enabling them to access Diksha Learning App (Developed by NCERT).

E-Shiksha Project

Installation of 150 Flat Interactive Panels (Smart TV) at government schools in Baran and Udaipur.



Ahimsa Bhavan

Construction of assembly halls at different government schools.

Construction of Classrooms

At Government Adarsh Senior Secondary School, Banokda, Kumbhalgarh and Government Secondary school, Kadechawas, Gogunda.

Smart Classrooms

Installation of Smart TVs (52' Inch) for students of class 1st to 10th. Covering syllabus prescribed by State Institute of Educational Research and Training (SIERT) and Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan.
